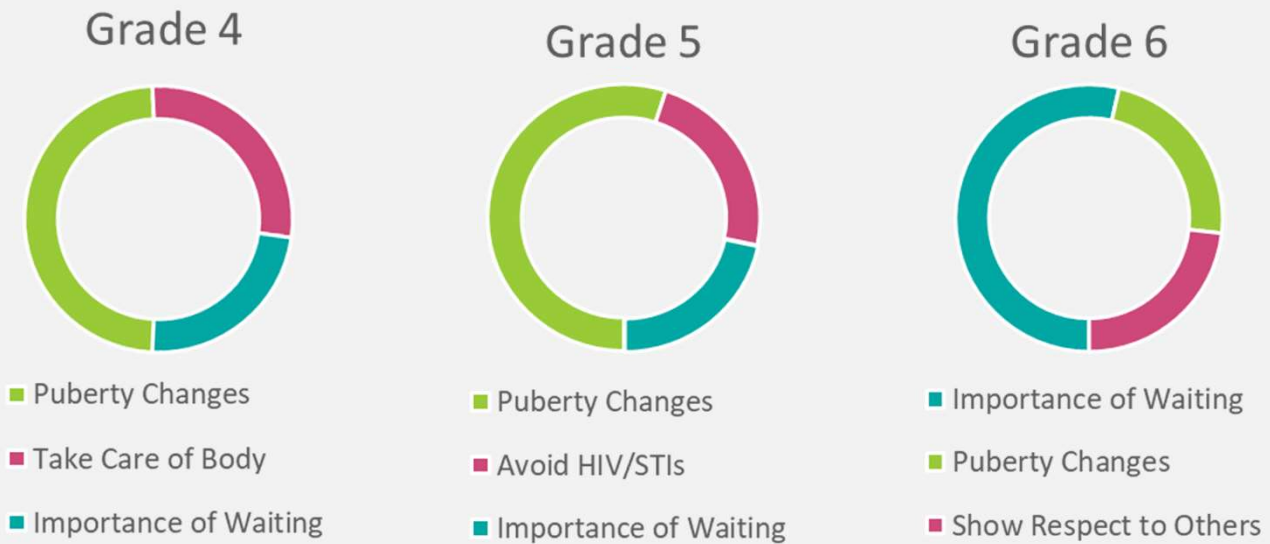

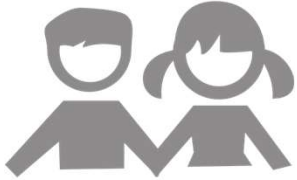

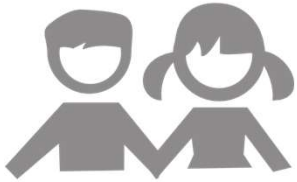


Students are more likely to report they can...



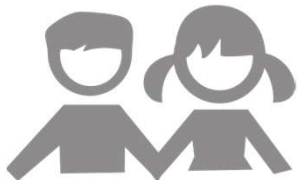

Boys (56% increase) & Girls (47% increase)*



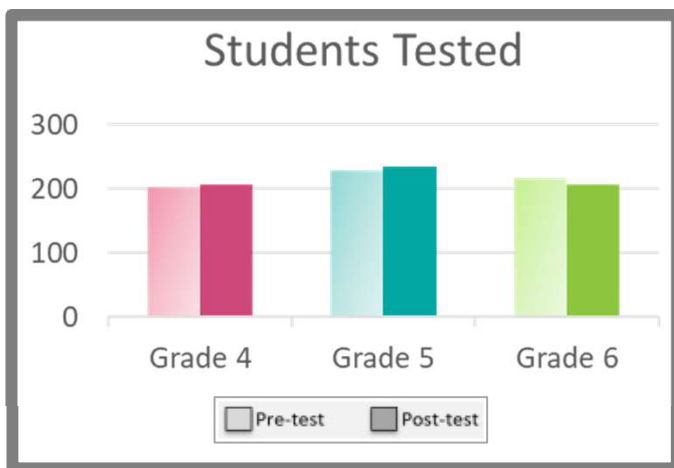
5th

Students in a large, urban, public school district took a pre-test prior to and a post-test following participation in the *Puberty: The Wonder Years™* curriculum.

Results from 764 matched pre- and post-tests indicate several statistically significant, positive changes in knowledge, attitudes, and skills.

* Statistically significant changes from pre- to post-test.
