

### Lesson Synopsis

Students work in pairs as they list human body systems and identify ways they have changed since infancy and ways they will change into adults. Guidelines for a safe classroom climate are adopted for use throughout this curriculum, and the question box is introduced as a method for asking question anonymously. Students take a brief pretest on their knowledge about puberty. Strategies for communicating with parents and other trusted adults are generated, then implemented as the students do

# Grade 6: "I Wonder What Happens Next"

- Safe classroom climate, parent communication, puberty review
- 2. Review of female and male reproductive systems, communication about sexual behavior (was 6-3)
- 3. Hormones, brains, and social-emotional development (expands 6-3 to add social, emotional, cognitive changes)
- 4. Healthy relationships with consent and respect
- 5. Relationship challenges and what to do
- 6. Making responsible decisions about sexual behavior
- 7. Sexually transmitted infections: prevent and treat (new)
- 8. Refuse or report: responses to violence (was Optional C)
- 9. Accurate information: Be a CRAB (was 5-7 and Optional D)
- 10. Advocating for future me (new)

B: Genetics, Twins (same)

C: Fetal Development (was 6-2)

D: New Life (was 4-3)

 E: Understanding Ourselves and Others (nev lesson on gender and sexual orientation)



- Avoid personal questions and stories.
- Ask questions; questions are good.







# Overarching Changes: Teacher Requests

# Overarching Changes: Cutting Edge

Current issues, information, and strategies are included:

 Lessons are <u>closely aligned</u> to the National Sex Education Standards, 2<sup>nd</sup> ed, 2020

- Biological terms are used for anatomy and behavior, not gendered terms
- Consent is emphasized across all grades
- Interpersonal and sexual violence prevention and response is stressed
- Porn is addressed
- Media literacy is taught
- Sex positive approach replaces negative messaging
- Is updated and disseminated quickly


